### FORENSIC SKILLS YOU'LL MASTER

Guided by your chief investigator, your team will get hands-on with a range of specialist techniques, including:

#### BLOOD SPATTER ANALYSIS

This is the interpretation of bloodstains at a crime scene in order to recreate the actions that caused the bloodshed. Analysts examine the size, shape, distribution and location of the bloodstains to form opinions about what did or did not happen.

#### FINGERPRINT COMPARISON

No two people have exactly the same fingerprints. This uniqueness allows fingerprints to be used in all sorts of ways, including for background checks, biometric security, and of course, in criminal situations.

#### FINGERPRINT POWDERING & LIFTING

Fingerprint powdering and lifting is a technique used to reveal hidden fingerprints on surfaces by applying fine powder. The print is then carefully transferred onto tape or a card so it can be analysed for identification.

#### DNA PROFILING

DNA profiling is a forensic method used to match biological samples, such as hair or blood, to a specific individual.

It works by analysing unique patterns in a person's genetic code, much like a biological fingerprint.

#### HAIR & FIBRE ANALYSIS

At a crime scene, there are often tiny fragments of physical evidence such as hairs or fibres from clothing or carpeting, that can help tell the story of what happened. These are referred to as trace evidence.
