# SPY SCHOOL: FIELD CRAFT

The name's Bond, team Bond. You're on location to track down the suspects in a high-profile case but you're missing key pieces of intelligence. Your mission? Deploy your spy personas, take to the streets and work together to uncover the culprit...

The eagle has landed - your next mission is afoot. Using your smartphones, your team will navigate to hotspots plotted around your chosen location where a range of cryptic tasks will be waiting. You will each be put through your paces with plenty of photo and video challenges, codebreakers, memory tasks and riddles!

As you comb the streets (undercover of course), you'll gather key information about your suspect and earn points for great spy work! You'll then have the chance to scour the intelligence you collected and use it to pick the dastardly culprit from a lineup (there may or may not be bonus points involved here but we couldn't possibly say.)

You didn't hear this from us but watch out for the bonus curveball challenges, each designed to keep you on top of your spy game!

An eye for detail, a magnificent memory and a competitive streak is what's required of you and your fellow spies for this fun, outdoor team activity.



<b>RUNNING TIME:</b>	The ideal length of time for this activity is 2 hours.
<b>MIN/MAX GROUP SIZE:</b>	Suitable for 10 – 500 participants.

## HOW DOES THE ACTIVITY WORK?

This 'app-based' virtual team building activity is run using two pieces of software. The first is a gameplay app which each participant will need to download onto their smartphone or tablet. The second is Zoom which we would use for the initial briefing and results sessions (although we can use other platforms if required).

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO BEFORE THE EVENT?

Very little. Before your event we will send you a detailed 'event information sheet' with all of the information you and your teammates will need. This will include the confirmed date and time of your event, the name of your dedicated event host who will run your activity, and of course, the Zoom link that everyone will need to access the call. All you need to do is send this information sheet to all those taking part, – let us look after the rest!

## WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY OF MY EVENT?

On the day itself, everyone will be welcomed to the event by your event host as soon as they join the Zoom call. Once everyone has arrived, your event host will explain exactly what will happen during your activity and answer any initial questions. After that it's time to get cracking as the teams head out and begin their challenge.

## HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL BE IN EACH TEAM?

For this activity, we would recommend having around 5 people per team. Once your host has welcomed everyone and explained what will be happening during the activity, they will split the group into their teams.

## HOW MANY HOSTS/FACILITATORS WILL BE RUNNING MY EVENT?

For this event, we will have one event host/facilitator for every 50 participants. They will remain available throughout the duration of your event to make sure everything runs smoothly and answer any questions participants may have and solve any problem that may arise.

## WHAT HAPPENS AT THE END OF MY EVENT?

At the end of your event the facilitator will run through the results and declare the winners via Zoom. Once the results are announced and the 'wrap up' has finished, your hosts will leave the Zoom call and end the session.
