# TEAM QUIZ: GAME SHOW

Have you ever dreamed of being in 'the chair' on Who Wants to Be a Millionaire, or spinning the Wheel of Fortune? New to our remote series, our Game Show Quiz is inspired by the very best television game shows...

'Channel' your TV knowledge in this entertaining quiz that will see you and your team play through three interactive rounds of trivia and put creative skills to the test in photo and video challenges! Within each lively category, you'll complete questions and tasks based on much-loved classics. But watch out for the bonus challenges (you can't phone a friend or ask the audience!)

## THE AIM OF THE GAME

Hosted via video conference and one of our fabulous virtual event managers, teams will be up against the clock to complete each round and earn the most points before the timer hits zero.

Following an upbeat virtual briefing from one of our fabulous presenters, Round 1 will see everyone split into teams of 4-6 players, each with an assigned team room.

Each group will then work together (in their virtual rooms) through categories inspired by The Price Is Right, Catchphrase, Millionaire and many more!


Once teams have completed Round 1, teams will be faced with their first bonus challenge! This round is reminiscent of 'Supermarket Sweep' and is guaranteed to get everyone involved and having fun!

All players are then called back into the main meeting room (Zoom only) for Round 2 for a game of 'Name That Tune'. Following Round 2, everyone will be sent back into their team rooms to create a Dragon's Den style pitch for the second bonus challenge.

The third and final round provides a quick-fire finale, where teams will be against the clock to complete as many questions as possible before the timer hits zero!

## WHO WILL RUN MY EVENT?

This activity is one of our Remote Hosted events and will be run from start to finish by one of our experienced remote facilitators via video link (Zoom is our preference but we can use other platforms too).

For this event, we will have one event host/facilitator for every 50 participants. They will remain on your call for the duration of the event to make sure everything runs smoothly and answer any questions participants may have.

## HOW DOES THE ACTIVITY WORK?

This 'app-based' team building activity can be run in virtual or hybrid formats depending on your circumstances and situation.

**VIRTUAL:** Running this activity virtually, all participants can dial in to the Zoom call from wherever they are, whether it's at home or in the office, in the UK or abroad. Your dedicated event facilitator will welcome guests, deliver your event briefing remotely, split the group into teams, and run your event from start to finish. At the end of the activity, your facilitator will announce the results and 'wrap up'.

**HYBRID:** With some physical 'in person' teams taking part from the office or a venue, and some 'virtual' teams dialling in from home or elsewhere, the hybrid solution is a great way to get everyone involved in your event, even if they can't be there in the flesh. Just like the virtual option, your event facilitator will brief everyone via video link, arrange the teams, and run everything from start to finish.

## WHAT DO I NEED TO DO BEFORE THE EVENT?

Before your event we will send you a detailed 'event details sheet' with all of the information you and your teammates will need. This will include the confirmed date and time of your event, the name of your event host, the Zoom link that will be needed to access the call, and details of how to download the gameplay app. All you need to do is send this information sheet to all those taking part, and let us look after the rest!

## WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY OF MY EVENT?

On the day itself, everyone will be welcomed to the event by your event host as soon as they join the Zoom call. Once everyone has arrived, your event host will explain exactly what will happen during your activity and answer any initial questions.
